Limit your request to two typewritten pages. On separate paper type the grant response by following the numbering sequence below and label each response with the corresponding number.

- 4. Building Principal's signature to acknowledge submission of grant. <u>If this is a technology grant</u>: The district Technology Director must <u>also</u> <u>sign</u> to acknowledge that the grant complies with the district's technology plan.

Project Description. Explain your project so that committee members will fully understand your request. Include answers to the following.

- 5. Clearly state the objective of your project
 - a. why it is important
 - b. the number of students that will benefit from the project.

- 6. Explain how this project will enhance opportunities not currently available.
- 7. How is this project innovative?
- 8. How will this project encourage student achievement?
- 9. Which specific Illinois State Standard(s) will this project support?
- 10. Provide a clear implementation plan with a timeline for this project.

Fiscal

- 11. Amount requested in whole dollars. Attach a <u>separate list</u> of expenses/ items for which you are requesting funds including quantity and cost. (This does not count as one of your two pages.)
- 12. Detail how funds will be used.
- 13. Is the project self-sustaining?
